Week Commencing 24th September 2023

St. Paul in the passage to the Philippians is caught on the horns of a dilemma. He faces a choice between what would be so much better for himself on the one hand, and on the other hand continuing to work for the church in Philippi and elsewhere. His answer, given in a couple of verses omitted in today's reading, is to stay; and we know that his ministry was fruitful for many more years. His choice reveals his love and his imitation of Christ in laying down his life for his friends. We can also note what it is that he thinks would be so much better for himself – his death. His belief in the Resurrection and our call to share in it is thereby revealed, death is not something to be avoided at all costs but for the Christian it is the doorway to the fullness of life. We might ponder that last sentence in particular.
