SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT (B)

Week commencing 25th February 2024

'I trusted, even when I said: I am sorely afflicted' so sang the psalmist. Jesus in the garden of Gethsemane said, 'Father, if it be possible let this cup pass from me, nevertheless not my will but thy will be done' and so he travelled the way of the Cross – scourging at the pillar, crowning with thorns, carrying of the cross, crucifixion and death. His trust was not misplaced of course as on the third day he rose, body and soul, and entered into eternal glory on his Ascension. The martyrs ever since, hundreds of thousands of them, have imitated Jesus' trust and in most, if not all cases, have joyfully gone to their deaths. We might remember those words of St. Roger Wrenno I have often quoted, 'If you had seen that which I have just now seen, you would be as much in haste to die as I am now' and thereupon he was hanged the second time, successfully. Those without faith and therefore hope do not understand of course, preferring to cling to this earthly life for as long as possible. Something to ponder next time we are afflicted in body or soul.
