If your Partnership has thus far "shared" only between priests and stewards; now would be a good time to widen the sharing. If progress is generally slow; now would be a good time to redouble your efforts and I will help if you ask me to do so.

I have been asked what should be in a Parish Partnership Plan. There are no hard and fast rules but here is a suggested list that is open to addition, alteration and amendment. Let me know your thoughts.
