Easter Sunday is the celebration of the Lord's Resurrection, or, we might say, the celebration of Sundays. Every Sunday is the Lord's Day, rejoicing in the Resurrection, something which we can easily forget. Easter is marked by forty days of preparation during which self-denial is prominent, a reminder of this vale of tears through which we are journeying; it is followed by fifty days of celebration, a week of weeks, looking forward to its completion in heaven. In these fifty days we will be presented with various accounts of Jesus' appearances after his Resurrection, they are helpful pointers to an understanding of what Resurrection means, though we cannot have a clear idea of this while still on earth. What we can say is that those found worthy of a place in the Resurrection will be transformed, experiencing what it means to be human and alive in a radically new way. A place in the Resurrection is not guaranteed of course, it depends on God's grace and the extent of our willingness to truly know, love and serve God in this world by surrendering to that grace.
