## THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER (C)

St Joseph the Worker: Day of Prayer for Human Work

Week Commencing 1<sup>ST</sup> MAY 2022

In today's passage from Acts we read that the apostles were, 'glad to have had the honour of suffering humiliation for the sake of the name'. Most people don't like being humiliated, why were the apostles glad? Briefly, our experience of humiliation is generally the result of bullying in which the bully aims to belittle the victim. This frequently involves scornful comments about the victim's attributes e.g. appearance. Clearly this is wrong. In the case of the apostles, they were humiliated for their faith and who they were as children of God. This seems to be a different 'mode of attack' which they can resist because they are utterly confident in God's love for them and not concerned about their own, worldly, status. St. Paul in Romans, ch.8, has some very pertinent words including, 'nothing can separate us from the love of God made visible in Christ Jesus'. Finally, if we are mistreated for being Catholic then we ought to rejoice that we have been identified as Fr. Chris one.
