## SECOND SUNDAY AFTER THE NATIVITY (C)

WEEK COMMENCING 2<sup>ND</sup> JANUARY 2022

The second reading today gives us a passage from St. Paul's letter to the Ephesians in which he tells us what he asks for them when he prays. Clearly he asks for their good, as he does elsewhere praying for others. The blessing sought here is centered on the minds of the Ephesians and in particular something we could ask for also as we enter a new year. He wishes their minds to be clear about what has been revealed so that their hope is also clear. There is a lesson here for us. It is easy to get caught up in daily life, even in the good sense of seeking always to do God's will, so sometimes we need to be reminded of our destination. We are called to be citizens of heaven, members of the communion of saints, gloriously renewed in Christ and rejoicing for eternity in the vision of God. In the light of such a calling I think it is fair to say that not a few of our daily concerns become less pressing? What is really important?
