Today the Church recalls how Joseph and Mary brought Jesus to the temple in Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. They did this to obey the law which required that the first son born of Jewish parents should be dedicated to God. God made this law to remind his people how he brought them out of Egypt on the night of the Passover.
