TWENTY SEVENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR - A

October 2nd 2011

My dear friends,

The month of October is called the month of the Rosary, a 'spiritual cadence', so to speak, that derives from the liturgical Memorial of Our Lady of the Rosary, which is celebrated on the 7th of October. We are therefore asked to let ourselves be guided by Mary in this prayer, ancient and ever new, which is especially dear to her because it leads us directly to Jesus, contemplated in his Mysteries of Salvation: Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious. In the footsteps of (Blessed) John Paul II (cf. Apostolic Letter *Rosarium Virginis Mariae*), I would like to recall that the Rosary is a biblical prayer, interwoven with Sacred Scripture throughout. It is a prayer of the heart, in which the repetition of the Hail Mary directs the thoughts and affections to Christ and therefore becomes a trusting supplication to his Mother and ours. It is a prayer that helps us to meditate on the word of God and to assimilate Eucharistic Communion, modelling ourselves on Mary who cherished in her heart all that Jesus did and said, and his Presence itself." (Benedict XVI. Angelus, St Peter's Square. October 10th 2010).
