My dear friends

The beginning of November is unique in the journey of the Church's year with the feast of All Saints, followed by that of All Souls. This year, these special days are a day later than usual. November is a month of remembrance and we begin on All Saints day with the celebration of all those people who have reached the ultimate goal of the vision of God in heaven. We would hope to include in their number, those whom we have known and loved who have followed the teachings of Christ and now enjoy, the sight of God for ever.

The commemoration of All Souls is rooted in the Church's strong conviction that we, the living, have a serious responsibility in love to accompany with prayer those who have died, but who as yet must undergo the purification necessary before they are able to dwell in the all-encompassing love of God. The Holy Souls are those "who die in God's grace and friendship" but who are "still imperfectly purified... after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of heaven" - (Catechism of the Catholic Church 1030).

November List envelopes are available if you wish to write down the names of all your departed loved ones who will be remembered during Mass in the month of November. On All Souls Day (Monday November 3rd) there will be Mass at 7:30am, 9:15am, 12:15pm and 7:30pm. The 7:30pm Mass will be preceded by Vespers for the dead at 7pm.
