The central theme of today's readings is that we should have the courage of our Christian convictions in our daily life amidst the hatred and rejection that we face. In both the first reading and the Gospel, Jeremiah and Jesus are presented as prophets, chosen, consecrated and sent to their brothers and sisters as emissaries of the Word of God. The first reading tells us how God called Jeremiah as His prophet and equipped him to face opposition and rejection in his prophetic vocation and he anticipates Jesus, the greatest of all prophets. Today's Gospel shows us how Jesus faced scepticism and criticism with prophetic courage. Along with Jeremiah, Jesus and Paul believed that they were commissioned by God to proclaim a disturbing prophetic message. No matter how strong the opposition, the three had the conviction that God was with them.
