<u>THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT [A]</u> <u>April 3rd 2011</u>

My dear friends

The fourth Sunday of Lent, believe it or not, is the halfway point of the Season of Lent. There are 20 more days to go before Easter. On this "Laetare" Sunday, there is the theme of joy at the thought of God's loving plan to save us in Christ. The opening prayer says: "Father of peace, we are joyful in your son, Jesus Christ, who reconciles us to you".

This Sunday always coincides with Mothering Sunday. We wish all our mothers a very happy day. We give thanks for the unconditional love of our parents which made us who we are.

This weekend, our First Communion children celebrated the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. There are two more Saturdays before Easter for us to celebrate this Sacrament of healing and forgiveness. In Holy Week, your priests will be available for this Sacrament on the Monday [18th] and the Tuesday [19th] at 7:30pm. Ideally, we should try to come to Jesus in this Sacrament before the Easter Triduum begins.
