# FOURTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (C) WEEK COMMENCING 3<sup>RD</sup> JULY 2022

Jesus's appointment of the seventy-two disciples and sending them for the mission of evangelisation in today's Gospel, is a reminder that Christ needs us as His followers to commit our lives and times to spreading the Gospel message of salvation, peace, joy, and healing. The appointment of the seventy-two disciples has a reflection of the seventy Jewish elders who went up with Moses on Sinai and saw the glory of God (Exodus 24:1-9).
