Last Sunday, our reflection was focussed on the authority given to Peter. Jesus conferred onto him the leadership of the Church which he, Jesus, established for our salvation. Furthermore, Jesus at the end of his discourse strictly ordered them not to tell anybody that he is the Son of God.
