TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B) Week commencing 3rd October 2021

This weekend sees the launch of our Diocesan response to Pope Francis' encyclical, 'Laudato Si" concerning care for our common home, the earth. Copies of Bishop Alan's pastoral letter are available so parishioners can read and reflect upon it at their leisure. A couple of observations of my own. Firstly, if one analyses government commitments, of which there are many round the world, they are not sufficient to reduce global warming to a manageable level. China will be increasing its emissions of CO_2 until at least 2030 and we can note that that country's emissions in 2019 were both more than double those of 2000 and greater than those of the US, India and Russia combined. Secondly, we are seeing the impact round the world of the surge in demand for goods of all sorts, with shortages, disruption to supply chains etc. That demand is coming from individuals, ultimately, so we might reflect on Bishop Alan's quote of St. Teresa of Calcutta about drops of water in the ocean.
