We have a lot in common with Zacchaeus: We pay our taxes to the Government (HMRC) once a year. The tax collector Zacchaeus collected road tolls and taxes for goods being transported along local roads and sent these tolls to Rome once a year (Palestine was governed by Rome at the time of Jesus). However, what tax collectors like Zacchaeus paid was never checked by Rome to determine if the amount paid was correct which made this profession notorious for corruption. Therefore, it is no surprise that tax collectors at the time of Jesus were considered sinners! The people of Jericho were outraged with Jesus when he visited Zacchaeus in his home. This did not prevent Jesus from welcoming sinners; He is always waiting for you to turn to him. At the end of the passage today, Jesus said, "The Son of Man has come to seek out and save what was lost." (Luke 19:10). When you meet Jesus, you will never be the same again, you will want to give up any wrongdoings and live a new life of grace. This is what happened to Zacchaeus, he would no longer be dishonest. Let us turn to the mercy of Jesus and be healed of our sins. renewed and transformed Fr. Nixon
