## THE MOST HOLY TRINITY (A)

Week Commencing 4<sup>th</sup> June 2023



The solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity always occurs on the Sunday after Pentecost. This position in the Church's liturgical year suggests we are invited to look-back on the whole of the Easter season as a particularly special revelation of the Trinity. The events of Holy Week reinforce the revelation of Father and Son, Jesus' last words on the cross being, 'Father into your hands I commend my spirit'. Jesus had also revealed the Holy Spirit and promised that he would lead us into the complete truth. We are not here dealing with truth in the sense of knowledge of the material world but of a living and vital truth, that we are invited to come to know the Trinity by sharing the very life of God. Pentecost therefore ends the Easter season with the mighty manifestation of the Spirit who animates the Apostles, sends them forth to preach the Word of God with power. So we shouldn't get caught up in mathematical puzzles today but rather seek to know the Trinity in truth and love.
