## THIRTY-FIRST SUNDAY OF THE YEAR [B] November 4<sup>th</sup> 2012

My dear friends

This weekend on the 3<sup>rd</sup> November, we recall the actual day in 1837 when our parish church was solemnly opened. We are now officially 175 years old. It is appropriate that we have just recently celebrated the Feast of All Saints and All Souls and prayed for all those who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith. We ask God's blessing on our parish community as we continue on our journey, resolved to be Christ's witnesses in the world.

This weekend we launch the new parish history that has been updated by Fr Stuart Foster, Diocesan Archivist – who wrote the original history of the parish for the  $150^{th}$  celebration. The price of the book is £5 and includes the homily given by Bishop McMahon when he presided at our Mass of Thanksgiving on the  $3^{rd}$  May.

As we draw to the end of this 175<sup>th</sup> anniversary year, we join in this prayer from the Mass for the Dedication of a Church:

"We thank you Lord for this house of prayer. May it be for your family a house of salvation and a place for the celebration of your heavenly Sacraments. Here may the Gospel of peace resound and the sacred mysteries be celebrated, so that your faithful, formed by the word of life and by divine grace on their pilgrim way through the early city, may merit to reach the eternal Jerusalem."
