According to the Book of Numbers, while Israel was in the desert, a man called Balaam was engaged to curse them. However, God constrained Balaam to bless the people, and he also uttered several oracles, one of which promised the coming of a star – in its immediate context, a leader (probably King David) but for us, the star which leads the Wise Men to Jesus. In some depictions of the crib at Bethlehem, Balaam is shown pointing to the star. Also, the appearance of a star was widely believed to proclaim the presence of a god, for us, the true God made flesh. Finally, we can note that the star is at the service of Jesus, the heavens proclaim his glory.
