If they we-re attentive and had open minds, they ought to be amazed. The sentence from the second reading, 'He has abolished death, and he has proclaimed life and immortality through the Good News', contains so much which upends the messages we get from the world about us. We are familiar with the Good News, or at least have heard this and similar passages many times, but familiarity can lead to complacency, a loss of impact. As a suggestion for you to try this week, take those words of St. Paul while sitting quietly somewhere by yourself and read the phrase out loud (and even loudly), several times, and see what happens.
