My dear friends

It was a lovely surprise this week, when parishioner and local artist Francoise Guild, informed me that her painting of St James the Less and St Helen was completed. Thank you very much Francoise. We were able to put it in position in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel on our patronal feast day of SS Philip and James on Friday last.

It was suggested during our 175th anniversary year, that there should be an image of our patron saints in the church. The painting shows St James the Less and St Helen in glory looking down on the church dedicated to their honour. In the centre of the painting, is the hill of Calvary. St James, a cousin of our Lord, was the leader of the church in Jerusalem and was martyred there in the year 62AD. He carries the Bible as the letter of St James is attributed to him. St Helen, the Empress of Rome, wears a crown and carries her symbol of the Cross. She traveled to Jerusalem on pilgrimage to find the cross of the Lord, which she did in 320AD. At the top of the picture, we can see the Holy Spirit shining down and we are reminded of Our Lord's words in the Gospel today: "The Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all I have said to you". *John 14*

May St James the Less and St Helen, our special friends in heaven, always pray for us.
