What's so special about the number 153? Why, in describing the great number of fish which the Apostles in today's Gospel caught, did the writer think to provide the exact number? St Jerome, one of the early Church fathers, noted that it was believed there were 153 different types of fish in the Sea of Galilee and so this is one for each type of fish caught. We can see in this a symbol of the universal mission Christ gave to the Apostles. Today's Gospel is mirrored by an earlier account at the beginning of Jesus' ministry when he called the fishermen Peter and Andrew. He promised that they would become fishers of men. The same Christ, now risen from the dead, commands them to take the Gospel to the entire world. We can do the same as we strive to live out our faith with joy and integrity in this Easter season.
