My dear friends,

We come together to celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. As we celebrate it on a Sunday, it is a little more than forty days since Easter. Today, we remember the words of Jesus in John - Chapter 14: "I am going now to prepare a place for you, so that where I am you may be too". Christ has ascended into heaven to prepare a place for us, where he has gone, we hope to follow.

On Ascension Day, Our Lord also gave the Apostles the commission to proclaim the good news throughout the world. He told them to wait and pray for the coming of the Holy Spirit; who would empower them for mission.
