There is an ancient saying, 'Man proposes, God disposes' which dates back to at least St. Thomas a Kempis and, as we hear today, is firmly rooted in the scriptures. Many people today would most likely dismiss the saying if they knew of it; certainly people act as if it were not true at all. If we consider the world around us, then it does operate according to the will of God as we discover through investigation and formulate in 'laws'; though that does not mean God has to will every individual event individually.
