## TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B) WEEK COMMENCING 6TH OCTOBER 2024

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that marriage is a sacrament, a divine covenant that mirrors Christ's unwavering love for the Church. This sacred union transcends mere human agreement; it is a relationship blessed by God. Jesus' response to the Pharisees makes this truth very clear when He stated, "From the beginning of creation God made them male and female. That is why a man must leave his father and mother and the two become one body" (Mark 10:6-8). The permanence of the marriage bond necessitates love, sacrifice, and faithfulness, with God at the centre, guiding couples on their journey toward holiness. The Church firmly teaches that divorce contradicts God's design for marriage, which is intended to be a lifelong commitment. To emphasise the gravity of this sacrament, Jesus spoke against divorce with resolute clarity: "What God has joined together, let no one separate" (Mark 10:9). This statement emphasises the sacredness and indissoluble nature of marriage as ordained by God.
