## FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER [A] - [World Day of Prayer for Vocations] May 7<sup>th</sup> 2017 - Parish Mass Book 262

On the fourth Sunday of Easter, the Gospel is always from the chapter 10 of John's Gospel, "The Good Shepherd".

"I am the Good Shepherd" is mentioned twice, (vv. 11:11, vv. 11.14) in this Gospel pericope. In here, Jesus would like to emphasize the self-giving, the mercy element of his life. As a "Good Shepherd" par excellence, he lays down his life for us, his sheep. An obvious thing, but in contrast with those who are just simply hired to look after the sheep.

The latter kind of shepherd, first of all thinks only of himself; busies himself with enterprises that concern only of how to gain; lives a happy-go-lucky life style and does not mind his duties and responsibilities. Secondly, he is carefree person . That is why when the sheep are being attacked by evil "wolves" he does not mind this at all and, worse, he runs away before an imminent danger.

Jesus instead is different, HE is our GOOD SHEPHERD. He takes care of us always and is always ready to give his life as a proof of his love and concern for us. His relationship with us is so strong and flawless that he even sacrificed his whole and entire life for each of us.

Moreover, this Good Shepherd also desires that we, his sheep, should build our intimacy with him. He wants us to identify ourselves with him, conducting our daily affairs in the light of his teachings. He even added saying: ..."my sheep, I lead, they know my voice and follow me."

Frankly speaking, do you know your shepherd whom you follow everyday? Do you listen to him? Or better still, do you love him?

Lastly, the Good Shepherd has only one ultimate goal: to gather the flock together as one and to lead them into his fold so that there will be one flock one shepherd. Are you IN or OUT? Send O Lord, holy apostles into your Church.
