A common criticism of God is that he doesn't deal with the problems of the world, as defined by the critic e.g. why does God allow people to starve? The person doing the criticism usually then goes on to say that they won't believe in such an 'inactive' God. If we reflect on today's readings, we can see how such people have got things the wrong way round. The problem is their lack of faith, which they then seek to justify by putting God on trial on their terms. Jesus visits his home town and is unable to do much because of the townspeople's lack of faith, which is linked to their ideas about who Jesus is. One can imagine, after Jesus has left the town, the unbelievers agreeing among themselves that he wasn't anything special and that was 'proved' by his lack of miracles and so they remained in ignorance.
