## St John's Abbey Site, Saturday, 14 September [Open from 10:30am - 4pm]

There will be a display of Abbey history under the arches of the 13<sup>th</sup> century Gatehouse, the only structure remaining of what was once the fourth largest Abbey in England.

2pm: Talk by Paul Everett on Eudo, founder of the Abbey and of Colchester Castle

#### Sunday, 15 September [Open from 10:30am - 4pm]

Access to Gatehouse room and display downstairs all day.

**11am:** Short talk entitled "Cromwell to Cromwell" about the influence both men had on the Abbey site, given by Jennie Guthrie-Stevens.

**2pm**: "Poetry at the Gatehouse". Linking through poetry the sacred history of the site from the first 9<sup>th</sup> century Anglo Saxon church of St John the Evangelist to Blessed Robert Southwell, a Jesuit martyr whose link to Colchester was through his aunt, Katherine Audley, sister-in-law of Thomas, Lord Audley, who remained steadfast in her beliefs throughout the 16<sup>th</sup> and early 17<sup>th</sup> century. Please bring your own chair.
