TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (A) Week Commencing 8th October 2023

The first reading and Gospel today could be considered very stern, both are real warnings that disciples need to 'produce fruit' otherwise they will be rejected. We need to take these warnings seriously. How, then, can we know if we are truly fruitful, what signs are there, if any? The second reading gives us a clue. It is a joyful passage, as St. Paul's letter to the Philippians is as a whole. He writes about purity, truth, nobility, honour, peace; elsewhere he expands on the fruits of the Holy Spirit as love, joy, peace, patience, kindness etc. Can we genuinely see these in our own lives because if so I believe we can say we are 'producing fruit'. We aren't necessarily grade A, perhaps we might be seen as wonky, imperfect as some supermarkets grade their fruit, nevertheless let's persevere and God will make us perfect in due time.
