THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD [A]

My dear friends,

Collect for Today: Almighty, eternal God, when the Spirit descended upon Jesus at his baptism in the Jordan, you revealed him as your own beloved Son. Keep us, your children born of water and the Spirit, faithful to our calling.

We might call the Baptism of Our Lord a second Epiphany, because it is also a manifestation, a showing. The Orthodox Church call this Theophany because, at the Baptism of Christ, God appears in all three Persons. Jesus of course had no need of baptism because he was without Original or actual sin. Nevertheless he chooses to be baptised, showing the way for all of us who do have need of it.

At Christ's baptism the heavens were opened: at ours heaven was opened to us. Let us thank God for this manifestation of His power in our lives.
