#### Today's Liturgy

The First Reading tells the story of how Elijah restored life to the son of the widow of Zarephath. This miracle prepares the way for the parallel of the Gospel miracle. In both cases the hand of God is seen in the activity of the one who performs the miracle. The widow of Zarephath hails Elijah as a 'man of God', and the people of Nain recognise Jesus as a prophet, and see his deed as a merciful intervention of God in favour of his people.

The Gospel story is not about faith (no faith is required), but about the compassion of Jesus. Luke portrays Jesus as someone who is deeply affected by human suffering and does not pass by. By touching the bier he would have incurred ritual uncleanness, but that didn't worry him. For Luke, the widow is one of the 'little ones' to whom the Good News is brought.

#### June - The month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

Jesus knew and loved us each and all during his life, his agony and his Passion, and gave himself up for each one of us: 'The Son of God... loved me and gave himself for me' *Galatians 2:20.* He has loved us all with a human heart. For this reason, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, pierced by our sins and for our salvation, 'is quite rightly considered the chief sign and symbol of that ... love with which the divine Redeemer continually loves the eternal Father and all human beings' without exception. *Catechism of the Catholic Church:478*
