SEA SUNDAY

Week Commencing 9<sup>th</sup> July 2023

At first glance it seems that Jesus is taking up an anti-intellectual position in today's Gospel passage, the learned and clever aren't to get a look in. Somewhat similar is Jesus' comment elsewhere, 'Alas for you who are rich'. I think we have here Semitic exaggeration, a common way of emphasising a point but not to be taken absolutely literally. Jesus is pointing out the risk of getting attached to intellectual effort, rather like wealth can be a trap; intellect is good in itself, obviously, but how well do we use it at times? We can also misuse our minds when we put effort into something which is intrinsically wrong (designing a better anti-personnel mine might be an example?). Our memory, understanding, will and bodies are meant to be directed towards God who is Good. We might call to mind St. Thomas Aquinas, one of the most brilliant intellects in human history with an immense impact on philosophy and theology, all given over to the service of God in charity and a saint of the church.
