My Dear Friends

On this Sunday we hear of the call of St Peter to be a fisher of men. His initial reaction to Jesus is one of repentance: 'Leave me, Lord; I am a sinful man'. This week on Ash Wednesday, the Church begins the journey of Lent, a journey of repentance and listening more attentively to the call of Jesus. It is good to plan ahead and decide this weekend how we will make the journey of Lent holy, through works of charity, penance and prayer. Let us begin Lent well by coming to Mass on Ash Wednesday and receiving the ashes as a mark of our wish to take Lent seriously.

Masses on Ash Wednesday are 7:30am, 9:15am (when we will be joined by the Juniors of St Thomas More's School), 12:15pm and 7:30pm. There will be 10am Mass at Mersea and the little ones will receive the ashes at the school in the afternoon.
