The second reading today is a hugely important passage of scripture, but here just two of many possible points. '...believing anything else will not lead to anything.' Firstly, the Gospel isn't something which follows fashion, nor is it decided by some sort of democratic vote. It is the Word of God, proclaimed and lived by Jesus and handed on to the Apostles so that it could continue to be preached throughout the ages. The Catholic Church can demonstrate it has remained faithful over the centuries to the preaching of the Apostles; many bodies today which claim to be Christian cannot do this, nor is what they teach fully in accord with the Gospel (just think of the so-called prosperity gospel, a monstrous aberration). Secondly, the Gospel is a Word of power, 'the gospel will save you.'. The Scriptures, especially when proclaimed in the Church, have the grace to change people.
