Some thirty years have passed between this Sunday and last. Last week we celebrated the visit of the Magi and today our Gospel presents us with his baptism in the Jordan. The years between are called the 'hidden years'. The only story we have from this period is the journey of the Holy Family to Jerusalem for the Passover where, on noticing Jesus is not with them, they return to the city to find him in discussion with the teachers in the temple. One story in thirty years. Part of this is to show that he lived an ordinary life like us – the same joys and hardships. He took on the fullness of our human experience. They also present us with a lesson that, in our own lives, God can sometimes seem hidden and silent. Jesus experienced that too on the Cross when He asked why he had been forsaken by His Father. It can be a comforting thought, when we feel that God is far away, to know that he chose to experience that for Himself as well.
