St. Paul gives us this Sunday a series of imperatives. including 'Be happy at all times' and 'pray constantly'. How might we understand these? A worldly approach would likely dismiss them as exaggerations, arguing for example that no-one can pray constantly because, at the very least, a person has to sleep at times. Someone with faith might be tempted to agree. In, 'The way of a pilgrim', a Russian classic from the 19th century, we read how one man on hearing the command strove to fulfil it, and succeeded. In his case it was the Jesus Prayer, repeated frequently, which eventually became so much a part of him that he was offering the prayer even in sleep; not always in words but in attitude. It is a matter of our spirit being filled with the Holy Spirit. Jesus himself promises that the joy of the Spirit will complete our joy ('Be happy at all times'). St. Paul, I would infer, was speaking from experience when he wrote those words. On this Gaudete Sunday may we all ask that the gifts of the Spirit be renewed in each of us. Fr. Chris
