# SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (A) Week Commencing 14<sup>th</sup> May 2023

We are nearing the end of the Easter season; It seems to have gone by so quickly! This means we can start turning our minds to the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. It is on Pentecost Sunday that some of our young people will be confirmed. This is an image we are given in the first reading where the apostles come to invoke the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on those who had been baptised. For practical reasons of mobility, the Bishop delegates parish priests to take this responsibility in his absence. As the spirit descends on our confirmandi we pray that they will experience a new Joy and a new Exodus as is sung about in the psalm, passing from former ways to newness of life by the power of God's spirit. A newness characterised by a life of love. When we look at what Jesus has proposed for us to live we are left in wonder and when we observe what that looks like in the newly confirmed we are left wondering. The sacraments are not magic, they "work" by invoking a narrative entering the story of God's love for us and the world. If we do not approach the sacrament with hunger and humility at being invited in to such a narrative then it's no wonder that many leave it wondering what if anything just happened. Let us prepare for the Holy Spirit by cultivating a hunger for God and his loving plan for our life.
