SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER <sup>(B)</sup> Week Commencing 16<sup>th</sup> May 2021

This Sunday's Gospel is part of what is known as the priestly prayer of Jesus, uttered at the last supper, because in it he makes it clear that in his Passion and death he is the Lamb of sacrifice and also the priest who offers the sacrifice (himself). He prays that we might be consecrated, in other words dedicated, to the truth. Every validly baptised person, at the moment of their baptism, begins to share in the priesthood of Christ. It is the priesthood of all the faithful (on which the distinct ordained ministry builds). We can call to mind the words of St. Paul, 'With Christ I hang upon the cross'. In baptism we are joined to Christ on the cross and so we also share in his priesthood. The baptised exercise their priesthood when they offer themselves, in their thoughts, words and deeds, to the Father as Jesus did in his daily life and especially on the cross. Every baptised person who lives up to their vocation thereby helps build up the Church, the Body of Christ, which is the new creation in its beginnings. The world, in the Gospel passage, is the old order which is passing away. Fr. Chris
