# THE RESURRECTION OF THE LORD (C) WEEK COMMENCING 17TH APRIL 2022

We have journeyed through Holy Week; Good Friday was a day of mourning, Holy Saturday a time of waiting and now the joy of the Resurrection. We might stop for a moment and ask ourselves how the first Holy Week would have been experienced, and in particular the evening of Good Friday. The disciples didn't know what was going to happen, unlike us. We can imagine their shock and distress; yet again it seemed that evil had overcome good, the political and religious leaders doing what so often happened, brutally maintaining their positions. The joy of the Resurrection would have struck the disciples powerfully. Since then there have been, and continue to be, many similar 'Good Friday' situations, hopes dashed, perhaps a sense of helplessness. The Resurrection is God's answer to all those moments of evil apparently overcoming goodness. Christ's victory is assured, he is risen, and we can be certain that evil will not be the final answer. As the first disciples were amazed at God's definitive answer to the cross, we won't necessarily be clear how that victory is manifested in our days, nevertheless he is risen. Finally, that victory is ours individually too, we are promised the end of our sin and death. Alleluia. Fr Chris
