### THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT (B)

"Gaudete" Sunday

Week commencing 17<sup>th</sup> December 2023

In the second reading today, part of St. Paul's first letter to the Thessalonians, there is the phrase, 'for all things give thanks to God.' At first glance perhaps we might think those words are unexceptional, but what about that little word 'all'? St. Paul meant what he wrote and didn't envisage exceptions; in his own life after his conversion, as he tells us, he was shipwrecked, flogged, often hungry yet he gave thanks to God for those moments. How do we deal with situations that don't go as we hoped, or events which come upon us surprises? We're faced again with that phrase from the Our Father, 'thy will be done on earth'. We can also note that St. Paul, in giving thanks to God for all things, was full of joy and peace. In contrast it would seem that people who don't receive what they expected end up unhappy and grumbling about life and God.


