My dear friends,

This weekend we approach a new beginning in our journey through the Church's year. This Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent when the Church starts her spiritual journey towards Easter. It seems to me that this weekend brings an opportunity to plan ahead and decide how we will make the best use of the opportunities the Lenten season presents to us.

It is good to begin Lent well by coming to Mass on Ash Wednesday, and receiving the ashes as a mark of our repentance. The only extra service is on Friday evenings at 7:30pm when we pray the Stations of the Cross. This coming Friday will be at St James the Less and then we alternate with our neighbours at St James the Great.
