THE MOST HOLY TRINITY [A]

19th JUNE 2011

"Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ" – a greeting for Trinity Sunday.

These words from St Paul are one of the three greetings that will be used when the new translation of the Roman Missal is introduced this September. The most familiar greeting is "The Lord be with you". This reminds us of the angel's greeting to Mary at the Annunciation. The response we will now make is "And with your Spirit", which we know it is a more faithful translation of the original Latin "Et cum spiritu tuo".

The priest prays that the Lord will be present to the community and the people respond that He may be specially present to the presiding ordained minister. This greeting and response occurs four times during the Mass; at the beginning, before the Gospel, before the Eucharistic Prayer and before we are sent forth to bring Christ to the world. We can reflect on how important is this dialogue between the priest and the community. The

third greeting, also from St Paul, has been slightly changed to "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.

This is my prayer for you on this special day.
