My dear friends

On this Palm Sunday we begin the solemn celebration of Holy Week and follow Jesus through the events of his Passion, Death and Resurrection.

On **Monday** we have Mass at 9:15am. It is also the Deanery Day of Prayer from 10am-10pm. During these twelve hours the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed on the Altar and Priests from our Colchester Deanery will be available for Confession and/or counselling. Please let people know. It may be helpful for them.

Tuesday, Mass at 9:15am Priory St and 11:00am at Monkwick with an opportunity for Confession.

Wednesday – Masses are at 9:15am, 12:15pm and 10:00am Mass at Mersea with Confessions. In the evening at 7:00pm, there is the **Chrism Mass** at Brentwood Cathedral to which everyone is welcome: The Bishop blesses the Holy Oils to be used during the year and all the priests of the diocese renew their priestly commitment.

Maundy Thursday - there is the Mass of the Last Supper in the evening at 8pm. We remember the Institution of the Eucharist and re-enact the Washing of the Feet. At the end of the Mass we can watch at the Altar of Repose until Midnight, recalling Jesus' Agony in the Garden.

Good Friday – 10am Stations of the Cross at Mile End, 10:30am Children's Stations at Priory St. At 11:45am we will assemble at Headgate for our Walk of Witness to Lion Walk. Here at 3pm is the **Celebration of the Lord's Passion** and Stations of the Cross at 7:30pm.

Holy Saturday – the Church waits at the Lord's Tomb and at 8pm – the **Easter Vigil** is the first Mass of the Lord's Resurrection.

Easter Sunday – all the Masses are at the usual time, as we greet with joy our Blessed Lord on his Resurrection day.

May God bless your journey through Holy Week and Easter.
