#### THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT (C)

WEEK COMMENCING 20<sup>TH</sup> MARCH 2022

I'm sure we are familiar with the idea, prevalent in Jesus' day, that to be rich and healthy was a sign of God's blessing and therefore proof that the person was 'good' whereas being poor/sick was the opposite. This also means that a person who did 'good things' expected to be rewarded by God. I would suggest that this idea still occurs today. Thus, we do find people who practise a religion, say prayers etc, but when something happens which is unwelcome eq illness, they get upset at God for not keeping his side of the bargain (a bargain they have imagined). Similarly, doing something 'extra', such as saying more prayers, so as to 'win' God's favour and be rewarded with a successful exam or job interview. Jesus rejects all such bargaining and requires repentance, using a word which means a deep conversion, a radical turning around rather than just saying sorry. Repentance means we know our inability to do anything good without God's grace, while also knowing that we are God's children and heirs to the Kingdom by his free gift – humility and dignity together.
