My dear friends

On Monday of this week, we heard that Pope Francis has appointed Fr Alan Williams SM, currently the director of the National Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham, as the seventh Bishop of Brentwood. His episcopal ordination will take place at Brentwood Cathedral on 1st July 2014 at 12 noon.

Until that time, Bishop Thomas will act as Apostolic Administrator and we will refer to our Bishop-elect Alan in the Eucharistic prayers.

The bishop-elect was born in Oldham, Lancashire in 1951. He took final vows in the Society of Mary [Marist Fathers] in 1981 and was ordained priest in St Anne's Whitechapel in 1983. Fr Alan holds degrees in theology, psychology and religious education and has served in a number of pastoral roles. He has worked as a teacher and chaplain in secondary schools. He also served as Catholic Chaplain at Sheffield Hallam University and taught Christian Spirituality at postgraduate level.

He is a former major superior of the Marist Fathers in England and has worked as a parish priest in the Archdiocese of Southwark. At Walsingham he has had overall responsibility for pilgrimage and retreat work. We give thanks for the appointment of our new pastor and pray for him on this special day. We remember too our outgoing bishop Thomas, who sends us a pastoral message to be read today.
