Do not be afraid.....

Fear is a strange phenomenon, it never comes from God. Fear of other people or their approval can lead us to forgo our religious beliefs. Think for a moment of the Divine Love who willingly went to the cross to redeem the sin of the world. That is the price Jesus paid to gain us an eternal reward. The Heart of Mary prayed for endurance during this trial. These two complement and inspire devotion. Two striking images of the Sacred Heart come to mind.
