TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (C) WEEK COMMENCING 21ST AUGUST 2022

In His response to the question put before Him in today's Gospel, Christ invites everyone to be part of the kingdom of God. Salvation is no longer an exclusive reserve or a privilege of the Chosen People (Jews) alone. Despite the long and the Deuteronomistic history of the Jewish people with Scriptures and prophets, many Gentiles (non-Jews) who embraced the message of salvation will enter the Kingdom of heaven ahead of some of them. Remarkably, it is essential to bear in mind that the first followers of Jesus were members of the Chosen People. *Narrow door.* The path to salvation is open and the invitation is clear, but following Christ require self-renunciation, a life of deep prayer, and unconditional love for everyone. The kingdom of God will not necessarily be populated with the people we expect to find there. Some perfectly respected religious leaders claiming allegiance to Jesus may not enter the kingdom of heaven because of their hypocritical piety. Importantly, just listening to Jesus' words and admiring His miracles and Powers is not enough to usher us into heaven. We must turn away from our sins and put our trusts in God to save us. God's kingdom will include people from every part of the world, but there will be many surprises. Some who we despise now will be greatly honoured and whilst some influential people here on earth will be left outside the gate of heaven. What matters to God is not a person's earthly popularity, status, wealth, heritage, or power but his or her commitment to Christ. How do our values match with what Christ tells us to value? Put God first in your life and you will join people from all over the world who will take their places in the heavenly banquet.
