SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER (C) WEEK COMMENCING 22ND MAY 2022

Mum: "Get up Son, it's Sunday and it's time to get ready for Holy Mass."
Son: "But why do I have to go?" Mum: "Because I said so." Son: I am not a child anymore, you have to give me a better reason than that" Mum: (thinks for a moment...) "People are waiting for you, you're their Parish Priest!" Dear friends in Christ after a long time away, this Pentecost the Sunday Obligation returns. As Catholics, unless there are serious reasons to prevent us we are bound to attend Mass on Sunday each week in person. Since the beginning of Christianity the Sunday Eucharist has been understood as truly right and just our duty and our salvation. Indeed many have heroically accepted death rather than miss the Sunday Mass. This witness flows from faithfulness to the third commandment to keep the Sabbath day Holy. Seven days without Holy Mass makes one weak and worse still puts us in a state of mortal sin! In God's goodness and wisdom, He has given us six days for work and one day for worship, recreation and rest. The word obligation itself comes from a Latin root meaning to bind. Jesus tells the Church in Matthew 18:18 "What ever you bind on earth consider it bound in heaven." The Church as a faithful mother has bound her children to attend Sunday mass each week here on earth as a means of binding us more concretely to our ultimate end, union with God in heaven. So, it's time to get up and go to Sunday Mass, All of heaven is waiting for you.
