Much of the history I studied at school seemed to be about battles, principally between kings, emperors and suchlike. The Old Testament has its fair share of wars also. The reasons for such fighting are varied, even today, though money and power usually play a major role. One could argue that what is common to all strife is the human tendency to form groups which give a sense of identity while also emphasising how different they are from others. St. Paul reminds us that Jesus came to bring peace, not as the world sees it, but a peace which comes from the Cross because through it the whole human race is reconciled to God. The Church is the community of those who have received this reconciliation. Members are called to be witnesses to it by trying to be above worldly differences. We don't always succeed but we ought to persevere.
