THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER (A)

Week Commencing 23rd April 2023

There are several post-Resurrection appearances of Jesus recorded in the New Testament, this Sunday's being notable for the length and detail given. It takes place on the day of resurrection itself, the first Easter Sunday we might say, so it is not surprising that the disciples are in a state of confusion and turmoil. The previous weekend Jesus had entered Jerusalem to acclamations of Hosanna, then came his Passion and death a few days later, now two of his disciples encounter Jesus alive. Much could be said about the meeting, the Gospel itself has the principal focus on how they recognise Jesus in the breaking of bread and how, once they had recognised Jesus at that moment, he vanished from their sight. The emphasis is that from now on the disciples ie the church, would find Jesus in the breaking of bread, the Eucharist. Jesus' appearance to them wasn't accidental, nor was the choice of day, it was a deliberate encounter with a deliberate aim, and connects back to the Last Supper. On the day of Resurrection itself, Jesus confirms the importance of the Eucharist and of his Real Presence therein.
