Diving Mercy Sunday

Week Commencing 24TH April 2022

As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday on the Second Sunday after Easter, we ponder on the Mercy of God upon us. There is a story of a young French soldier who deserted Napoleon's army, but he was recaptured within hours. To serve as a deterrent to other soldiers, the repercussion for desertion was the death penalty. When the mother of the young soldier heard of her son's ordeal, she went to plead with Napoleon to spare her son's life. Napoleon listened to her plea but retorted, because of the seriousness of your son's offence, he certainly did not deserve mercy. The mother answered, "I know that my son doesn't deserve mercy, it wouldn't be mercy if he deserved it". From this story, we understand the awesomeness of Divine Mercy. None of us deserves it, yet God in His love through the Incarnation and the Paschal Mystery of our risen Lord has bequeathed His Divine Mercy on us unmerited. God's mercy resonates in our readings: many signs and wonders were done at the hands of the apostles; the psalmist echoes the goodness and endlessness of God's love; we should not be afraid, Jesus is the first and the last (all we need). Essentially, Jesus gives us peace and the gift of the Holy Spirit together with the Sacrament of Reconciliation. What a reservoir of Divine Mercy we have in the Church! In the Sacrament of Reconciliation God dispenses His Divine Mercy on us when the priest pronounces judgement of mercy in the prayer of absolution. Seminarian Moses Itene
